Language Arts and Reading

Phonics - review all letters, sounds and blends writing words on slates; journaling

<u>Handwriting</u> – Sentence structure and punctuation review and practice. Writing Valentine messages.

<u>More Literacy Activities</u> – Morning Message, The Daily News and Letter/Word Wall work. "Read alouds" will feature stories from Asia and stories about presidents and our country. The story dictation project continues. The children write a story. Each author chooses classmates to play the various characters in the story and the story is acted out. TEKS 110.11

Math

Work on telling time and patterning; story problems to solve using math facts to 10. Addition and subtraction practice and work with the 100 grid continue. **100 Day** activities, snack and projects! (111.12 TEKS)

Science and Social Studies

SOCIAL STUDIES: Complete study of Asia – this will include completing each passport and" flying" to Asia. Discuss President's Day and other American patriotic holidays. Who were George Washington and Abraham Lincoln? LFO – "Our First President".

SCIENCE - Mrs. Youngjohn is beginning a unit on the animal kingdom: ways to classify them; similarities and differences; oviparous or mammal and more. The first week will be a study of birds. (112.11 TEKS)

Health and Physical Education

P.E. – Kick ball and "Batter Up" on the ball field. Yoga animals and other poses.

HEALTH – How do we care for our teeth? Which foods help us to have healthy teeth? (116.2 TEKS)
