What's Happening in Pre-K

Theme: Texas March 6 - 10

Language Arts: We will read books about our great state such as, *I Spy in the Texas Sky, Texas Mother Goose,* and *Batty about Texas.* As we read these books we will chart what we have learned about Texas and add Texas words to our letter wall (Texas, bluebonnet, mockingbird, armadillo, friendship).

Emerging Literacy/Reading: We will be working on the high frequency sight words: big, one, red and blue. We will continue to work on identifying rhyming pairs and generating our own rhymes. We will also be thinking about the letter N and brainstorming words that start with N.

Fine Motor & Writing: We will be working on the letter N this week in our handwriting books. The children will complete their Texas books about Texas symbols. We will also be making clothespin horses that will work our fine motor muscles.

Math: We will work be counting out bands for our nine banded armadillos as we work on one-to-one correspondence. We will practice answering questions using graphs.

Social Studies: As we study Texas we will talk about how Texas is a state in the United States. We will think about its size in relation to other states when we look at it on a map. We will also talk about things that are made in Texas.

Science: Amphibians are the focus of Mrs. Youngjohn's science class this week. The children have enjoyed learning about birds, mammals. Snakes and reptiles during this unit about the animal kingdom.

Social/Emotional: As we discuss that Texas or Tejas means friendship, we will continue to talk about what it means to be a friend. **Physical Development:** We will ride stick horses like cowboys and have a cowboy relay race. We will also make our sight words fly in the parachute.

Fine Arts: As we make our Texas book we will be completing various Texas symbol illustrations using a variety of materials. In **Music**, we'll have fun with some more cowboy songs, folk songs and dances.
